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Difference Between Catalan and Spanish

1. Catalan is a non-phonetic language, Spanish is a phonetic language.
2. The Catalan language usually excludes the vowel “o” such as a cat is called “gat”. Spanish language nouns and adjectives can end in vowels such as o, e, o such as a cat is called “gato”.
3. Catalan uses consonant clusters. The Spanish language uses vowel sounds between consonant sounds.
4. The Catalan language uses apostrophe and hyphen in the spelling. This may not be the case in the Spanish language.
5. Catalan has more vowels than Spanish which has five vowel sounds.
6. Catalan shares some similarities with the Portuguese language. Spanish does not share similarities with the Portuguese language.
